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# Cellar

→ St Henri Shiraz 2012 | South Australia

St Henri is a time-honoured and alternative expression of Shiraz, and an intriguing counterpoint to Grange. It is unusual among high quality Australian red wines as it does not rely on any new oak. Released for the first time by Penfolds in the early 1950s (first commercial vintage in 1957), it gained a new lease of life in the 1990s as its quality and distinctive style became better understood. Proudly, a wine style that hasn't succumbed to the dictates of fashion or commerce. St Henri is rich and plush when young, gaining soft, earthy, mocha-like characters as it ages.

→ RWT Barossa Valley Shiraz 2004, 2006 & 2013 | Barossa 370

Penfolds RWT Shiraz presents an admirable alternative to the multi-regional sourcing and American oak maturation that are hallmarks of Grange, expressing instead, single-region Barossa Valley Shiraz matured only in French oak. The initials RWT stand for 'Red Wine-making Trial', the name given to the project internally when developmental work began in 1995. Naturally, now no longer a 'Trial' RWT Shiraz was launched in May 2000 with the 1997 vintage. Its style is opulent and fleshy.

Grange is arguably Australia's most celebrated wine and is officially listed as a Heritage Icon of South Australia. Grange boasts an unbroken line of vintages from experimental 1951 and clearly demonstrates the synergy between Shiraz and the soils and climates of South Australia. Grange utilises fully-ripe, intensely flavoured and textured Shiraz grapes. The result is a unique Australian style that is now recognised as one of the most consistent of the world's great wines. The Grange style is the original and most powerful expression of Penfolds' multi-vineyard, multi-district blending philosophy.

# Cellar

→ Matua Single Vineyard Syrah 2014 | Hawkes Bay 90

This Matua stand-out has depth and intensity, and reveals black pepper and black mineral notes and lifted oak with aeration. Medium-full bodied, the palate is elegant in proportion with succulent and luscious flavours of blackberry fruit alongside black pepper, violet and dark red florals and nuances of spice. Gold Medal winner in the NZ International Wine Show 2014.

→ Black Grape Society Central Otago Pinot Noir 2011 100

Flourishing with youth, this wine is vibrant purple in colour with a complex nose of Satsuma plums, and fresh sage intertwined with summer bramble and vanilla pod. The palate is rich and plush, with layers of dark cherry, spice and vanilla. The wine is very structured with well integrated oak supporting ripe tannins.

→ Saltram No. 1 Shiraz | Barossa 90

The palate is full and powerful with rich, elegant, varietal flavours of cassis, blood plum and cherries. The chocolate and liquorice notes following right through to the finish. This is a sumptuous wine with soft ripe tannins and great structure.

→ Matua Single Vineyard Chardonnay 2011 & 2013  
Marlborough 85

This Single Vineyard Wine has less oak, more fruit, with aromas of apple, white peach and roasted cashews. Minerally, fresh and crisp, it's just waiting for you to crack it open.

The most iconic red in the Wolf Blass stable, Black Label is not about individual regions or varieties, but rather about crafting the finest red blend from South Australian vineyards. With intricate complexity, intensity of fruit and magnificent structure, this is a wine to be savoured during life's extraordinary moments.

→ Wolfblass Platinum Label Shiraz 2008 | Barossa 320

The ultimate expression of the Medlands Vineyard terroir, Platinum Label Shiraz displays power, elegance and grace. This is a richly textured wine of opulence and balance with intense concentrated flavours, purity of fruit, remarkable length and exemplary focus, line and presence.

→ Matua Single Vineyard Alberino 2015 | Hawkes Bay 80

Exotic and aromatic on the nose. Juicy, refreshing flavours of apricots, citrus fruits and apple, crisp and fresh acidity and a touch of zingy ginger.

→ Rosemount Balmoral Syrah 2008 | McLaren Vale 110

Rich and layered with vibrant plum, chocolate and black cherry. A touch of liquorice and spice add complexity to the mid palate, along with subtle oak. The palate has a long and elegant finish, supported by soft velvety tannins.
